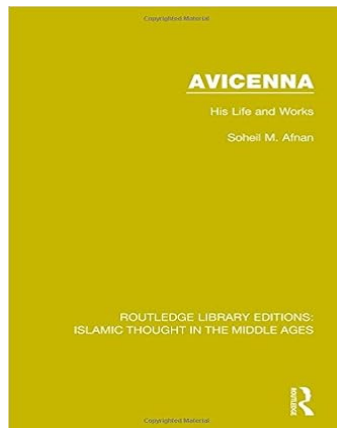

This book, first published in 1958, examines the life and works of Avicenna, one of the most provocative figures in the history of thought in the East.
